

HOSPICE 101



Hospice care focuses on the quality of life for people who are experiencing an advanced, life-limiting illness. Hospice care should be used when a person is expected to live about 6 months or less. Hospice care treats the person and symptoms of the disease, rather than treating the disease itself. A team of professionals work together to manage symptoms, so a person's last days may be spent with dignity and quality, surrounded by their loved ones.

WHO PAYS FOR HOSPICE?

The Medicare Hospice Benefit covers the cost of hospice care. Medicaid and private insurance companies often cover Three Oaks Hospice services.

- Senior living

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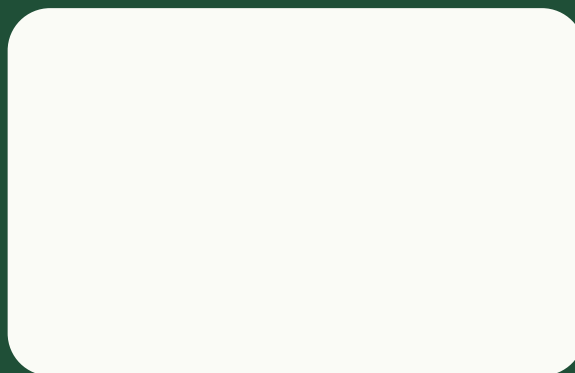

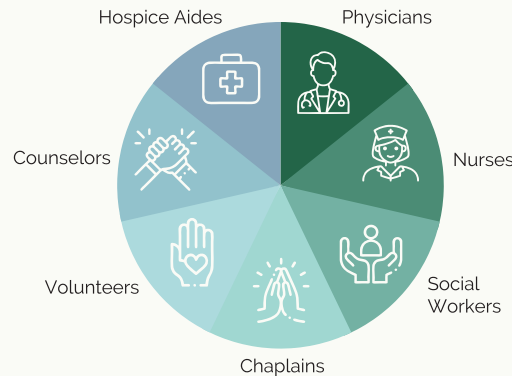
